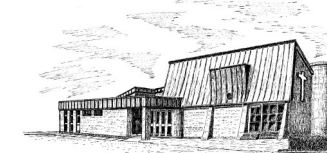

The mother-hen ministry

"In Joppa there was a disciple named Dorcas, who was always doing good and helping the poor." Acts 9:34

Dorcas could be said to have had a mother-hen ministry! Young parents and new Christians often need the steady support of more mature people.

Thank God for His love and support and ask Him to show you to whom you can be a "mother-hen" by giving love and support.

A mother in Israel

"March on, my soul; be strong!" Judges 5:12

These words were originally spoken by Deborah, a prophetess who learned to listen to God's voice. She became Israel's leader, which was amazing in a then male-dominated world! Her greatest gift was inspiring people to do far more than they ever thought possible. She was known as "a mother in Israel". The phrase "a Mother in Israel" was used by early Methodists to describe woman who inspired others in their homes and communities to turn to Christ and helped their faith in Him to grow.

Thank God for His encouragement and ask Him to show you to whom you could give encouragement and help in their journey of faith.

God the Mother

"As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you." Isaiah 66:13

God uses familiar human relationships to model the infinite variety of His love; He tells us He wants to be our father, friend, husband, lover, brother, boss and king. The above verse shows us He can also mother us with the gentle, tender side of His love.
