Long before a day in February was set aside to celebrate love, the world received a love letter that changed everything. The words of the Bible are priceless to us because they tell of the "love letter" God sent 2,000 years ago in the Person of His Son.

Sunday - "Keep on **loving** each other as brothers." (Hebrews 13:1) Pray that as we remember God's love to us, so may we be **loving** to others.

Monday - "**L**" is for **lost** - Pray for those who have never heard about Jesus and for those who painstakingly and lovingly translate God's Word into many different languages so that all can read about the Saviour in a tongue they understand.

Tuesday- "**O**" is for **Old** - Pray for the older folk you know, especially those in nursing homes. May they receive love and tender care in their latter years.

Wednesday -"**V**" is for **vulnerable** - Remember the many who suffer abuse in their own homes. May they seek and find help and love. Pray for the Samaritans in their work in this sphere. Remember too, the homeless, and pray for groups of people, like the Salvation Army, who run soup kitchens and offer places of shelter.

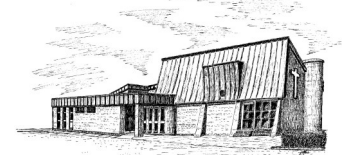

Saturday - "**G**" is for **guilty** - Some people are so burdened with guilt that they see no way of escape. Pray that they will hear the Gospel and come to know the one who offers forgiveness. Remember those in prison and pray for the folk who run Bible study groups there. May lives be turned around .

Peace Service - On Sunday 19th February 2017 at 4.00 pm Dalgety Parish Church will be holding a short service around the 'Peace Garden', everyone will be most welcome to join with us at this time.

The Peace Garden, planted with aromatic and colourful plants, features a four sided 'Peace Pole' that has written on it in 8 languages "May Peace Prevail On Earth", overlooked by a bench where you can sit and contemplate. The arms of the bench has the same message in braille set on brass plates.
