for freedom to replace fear

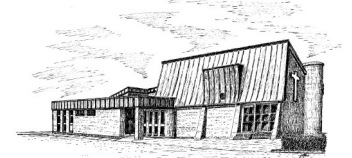
for there to be a better tomorrow.
