All who trust in His unfailing grace.

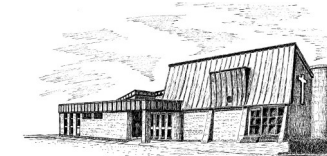
Hear the call of the Kingdom
