Changes!

The National Church now has two main 'forums' to help us in God's mission: Faith Nurture and Faith Impact. There is still much to be done to bring remits and vision together; please pray for those who work at 121 George Street, the Church of Scotland's Head Offices.

At Presbytery too there are changes afoot. General Assembly (GA) 2019 began the work of looking to make larger Presbyteries across Scotland. St Andrews, Kirkcaldy and Dunfermline Presbyteries have all agreed to follow a route that would bring into being The Presbytery of Fife. This proposal will go to GA in May 2020.

And of course the Special Commission of Presbytery has reported in February, and Presbytery agreed to ask groups of congregations to discuss a future with fewer buildings and fewer 'ministers'. The entire report will be made available very soon through the Presbytery and our own website, and in hard copy for those who would prefer that (please ask your Elder to put in your 'order').

For Dalgety Parish Church this means a conversation with 6 people from each of North Queensferry, Inverkeithing, Aberdour and ourselves: reducing buildings from 6 to 4, and Ministries from 3 to 2.5. A representative from The General Trustees will be on hand to help discussion about buildings, and someone from Place for Hope will lead the conversations which might at times be difficult.

In our own congregation Isobel Macfarlane has served 10 years as Session Clerk and with her two terms of office completing we have a new Session Clerk elect. Elma Doig, Convener of The Guild, will take over from Isobel, and we thank her for her willingness to serve. Please do support Elma and keep her in your prayers.

Isobel has been a wonderful Session Clerk. She has always been there to guide me through some difficult waters, calm me in some hairy times, and laugh with me in good times and not so good. Dalgety Parish Church owe Isobel a huge 'thank you' and although she might be thinking of sitting back in retirement I have a feeling that might not be the case!
